

Basic Fire Alarm

This class is designed to acclimate anyone, experienced or inexperienced, to Fire Alarm Systems.

This class covers the basics of designing and installing a Fire Alarm System. We begin with a brief overview of the codes and standards, the types of certifications and how to receive those certifications.

We then cover the fundamentals of a system and how the system works. We discuss Initiating Devices and Notification Devices and proper layout and spacing of these devices.

We discuss Ancillary Controls, and System Wiring requirements as required by the NFPA standards. We also cover Acceptance Testing and Inspection.

Upon completion, students should understand basic installation, operation, inspection, testing and maintenance of any Fire Alarm System.

Clean Agent Suppression

This class is designed to acclimate anyone, experienced or inexperienced, to Clean Agent Suppression Systems.

We begin this class with an overview of all of the Clean Agent Suppression products currently available. We do discuss Halon. We cover the manufacturers recommended procedures for installation and inspection, testing and maintenance. We cover the NFPA requirements for inspection, testing and maintenance, and then complete the class with an overview of the NFPA standards.

Water Based Suppression

This class is a basic overview of what a sprinkler system is, and the various types of sprinkler systems to be inspected. We cover the requirements per NFPA 25 for inspection, testing and maintenance.
